

Title I – EIP Parent Survey  
Lilburn Elementary School – 2006-2007

We received 1, 189 responses from parents. Not all questions on all surveys had an answer.

The responses indicated a high degree of satisfaction with Lilburn Elementary School. Over 95% of our parents responded positively to ten of the questions. Six more of seventeen questions about our school were answered positively by over 90% of those responding. 85.4% of parents were aware that Lilburn ES is a Title I school that provides support to their child. One additional question polled the parents about school uniforms. 71.3% of those responding agreed that they would like their child to wear a school uniform.

Parents are proud of Lilburn and expressed positive feelings about organization and administration. 99.2% of parents felt welcomed at Lilburn ES. 98.9% felt their child was safe at our school. 99.1% agreed that our school was clean and well-maintained, while 98% agreed the clinic helped their child when they were sick.

Parents had very positive responses about communication and learning at our school. 98.8% agreed that their child's teacher communicated with them. 97.5% agreed the teacher had informed them how to help their child at home and 99.1% agreed that homework had helped their child practice learning at home. 98.1% felt the Principal and Assistant Principals listened to them and 98% were notified about parent meetings. 93.4% agreed that AKS and promotion requirement information was provided to them. 94.8% were informed about the rules that children at Lilburn ES must follow. 96% knew their child was learning about computers and technology.

Parent involvement at Lilburn ES is high. 94.8% agreed that Lilburn ES provides time for them to volunteer and 90.3% of parents responding agreed that they participated in school activities. They support learning at home, 90.3% agreed their child reads every night at home. They show interest in our school with 93.2% wishing to become more involved in school.
