Students will improve in Reading, Writing, and Mathematics.

Results in 2004-2005

- Lilburn Elementary School (LES) students in every category made Annual Yearly Progress.
- 94.9% of LES 5th graders passed the writing Gateway on the first try.
- 90.8% of LES 4th graders scored in the top two categories of Gateway—Excellent and Effective.
- LES students continue to make progress on the Georgia Criterion Reference Test (CRCT).
- LES students in many categories exceeded the system and state average on the CRCT.
