

Installing the At-Home Component

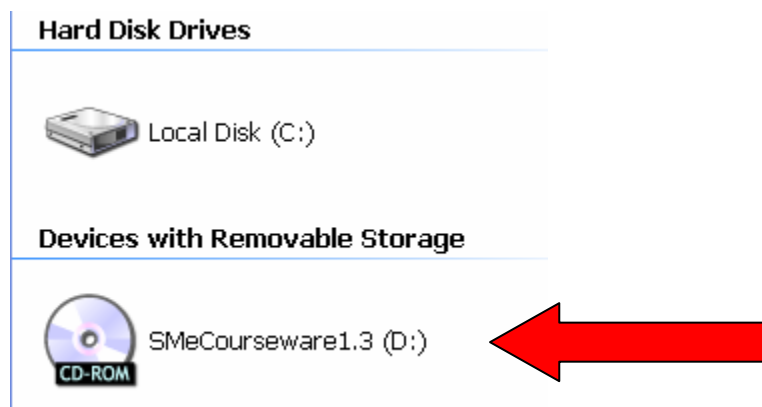
Before students can begin working on SuccessMaker At-Home, the Courseware Setup CD must be installed. You may also need to install Internet Explorer and QuickTime if your computer does not already have them installed. (Internet Explorer Version 5.5 or higher and QuickTime v5 or higher are required) **See the Home User Installation Kit for more information on these applications**

Courseware Installation

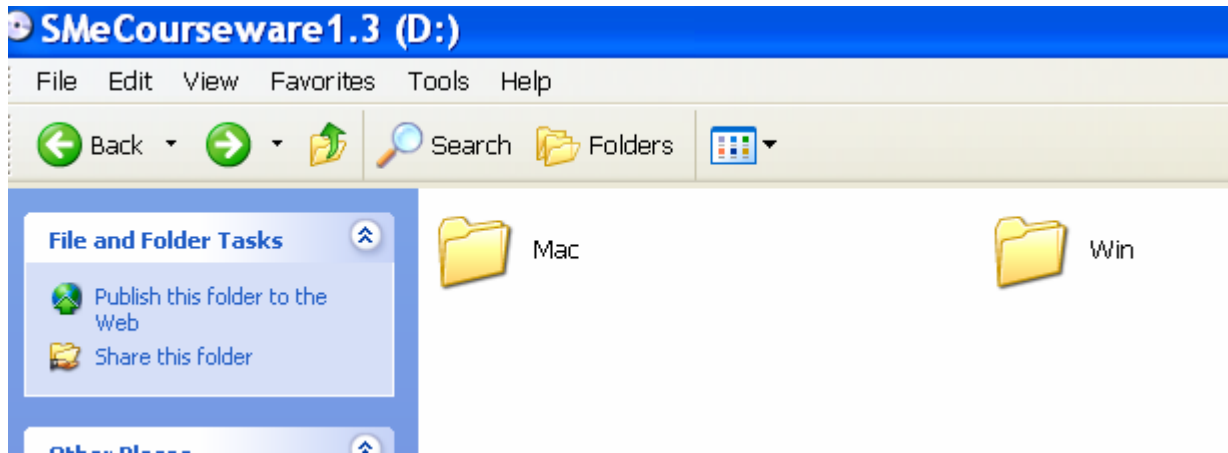
1. **Insert the “Courseware Set Up” CD into the CD Drive of the computer.**
2. **Double Click the My Computer icon on your desktop.**



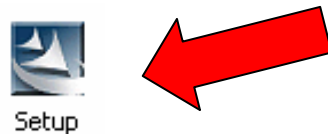
3. **Click on your CD-Rom Drive**



4. **Click on the Win folder.**



5. Click on the Setup icon. (The blue square with the little arrows through it)



- a. The Install shield Wizard will begin. Accept the defaults for installation. The InstallShield Wizard Welcome screen displays. Click **Next**.
 - b. Setup searches for Java Runtime Environment (JRE) version 1.4.2_03.
 - c. If JRE version 1.4.2_03 is found on your workstation, a message displays stating that this JRE version will be used. If a version higher than 1.4.2_03 is found, the higher version will be used. Click **OK**.
 - d. If JRE is not installed or the version installed is lower than 1.4.2_03, setup will install JRE 1.4.2_03. After JRE 1.4.2_03 is installed on your workstation, a message displays stating that this JRE version will be used. Click **OK**.
 - e. The Setup Status screen displays. The courseware installation may take several minutes. During installation, two dialog boxes display stating that .dll files were successfully registered to your workstation. Click **OK** to proceed.
6. At the end of the installation, you will be prompted to select between using the *SuccessMaker* Courseware on CD or DVD. Choose CD, and then click **Next**.
7. When the setup is complete, select **Yes, I want to restart my computer now**, and click **Finish**. The workstation restarts.

8. Close the CD-ROM drive contents window and remove the **Courseware Setup CD** from the CD-ROM drive.
9. You may now use *SuccessMaker at Home Follow Student Use Handout*

If you are you using Windows XP at home, you will need to go to our school webpage and download a batch file to run prior to using SuccessMaker. The web address is <http://www.lilburnes.org> and click on the SuccessMaker link.

Once the Install Wizard is completed, you can access the SuccessMaker program through your school's SuccessMaker Internet web site.
